### Monthly Programs Summer 2010

Our program for July will be small group studies of some painted canvases. Each group will brainstorm focal points, possible stitches, thread options, and embellishment ideas for their canvas and then present it to the group as a whole. This is a repeat of a very popular program from a few years ago.

Barbara Lewis will be guiding us in a blackwork project from the ANG book in August and September. The supply list is below. This is a small sampler piece to introduce a variety of classic blackwork designs.

#### Materials List for Aug/Sept

7" x 7" 25 ct. White Lugana even weave fabric (design is 2 ¾" x 2 ¾")  
zigzag or tape edges and attach to frame if desired

Black #8 perle cotton

Black cotton floss

#26 tapestry needle

Line drawing - This will be provided at the Aug. meeting.

## **WORKSHOPS**

**Barbara Lewis**

March 19 and 20 we will have Betty Chen Louis here, she normally doesn't travel to teach anymore but she likes us !! We are very lucky as she is an excellent teacher.

The piece is called Cyclamen Scroll and the kit cost is \$115. The design will be stitched on 11" X 20" white congress cloth. She has two pages describing what we will learn..needless to say a lot !

She wants me to stress that there is thread shading with a sharp needle and **THERE WILL BE NO GHOSTING**. That means that if you sign up and are sick you will get your money back but no kit.

She will take 20 students and I already have 10 signed up. I won't start taking money until probably October.
